

Interviews for Builders

These are general questions and prompts to jog your memory. Please feel free to answer as many or as few questions as you would like. There is no “right” answer to any of these questions nor a correct length, they are merely meant to be a jumping off point.

Introduction Questions

1. What is your name? (if it is an oral interview, please have the participant spell their name).
2. What was your role in the Games?
3. How did your involvement in the Games come to be? OR why did you want to be involved in the Games?

The Games (general)

4. Tell me about your experiences with the Games prior to your participation.
5. Tell me about your experiences with the Games post-participation.
6. Tell me about how the games have changes since you first started and today.

The Games (specific)

7. How do you think the Games impacted you at the time?
8. How do you think the Games impacted your future?

Participant (specific)

9. Tell me about any notable experiences that happened at the Games (as many as you like).
10. Tell me about your best memories of the Games (as many as you would like).
11. Is there anything else you would like to tell me that I didn't touch on?
